Being an industry leader in child care and development My Small Wonders is committed to excellence and instilling a lifetime love of learning in all children who walk through our doors. We would be honored to have the privilege of partnering with you to care for your child during their early years. We continually strive to 'make our best better' and can only do that with the help of our families. When parents and providers work together and communicate it helps ease the transition to child care and ensure that the children grow happy, healthy and strong.

My Small Wonders is locally owned and operated by My Small Wonders, Inc. Our facility opened in 2008. The officers of My Small Wonders, Inc., Scott and Tammy Werner, have been involved since December of 2011. Our Director is Lindsay Steele. Our Assistant Directors are Laura Kettner and Kari Rader. We are licensed with State of Oklahoma-Department of Human Services for the care of 240 children ages 6 weeks through school age. We currently transport to Cross Timbers, John Ross, Heritage and Centennial Elementary for those enrolled in all day Pre-K thru 3rd grade. We offer only full time enrollment but parents can choose to use any or all portions of the week according to their needs. Our center is open from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Parents may not check in before 7:00 a.m. and we ask that they arrive in time to pick up the children from their classrooms, gather their belongings and exit the room by 6 p.m. so that the teachers may start their end of day activities.

We realize that each child is unique and providing them with a positive early learning experience is a critical step in leading them down a path of educational and social success. My Small Wonders employs a team of child care professionals who are dedicated to preparing a developmentally appropriate curriculum tailored to enhancing your child's emerging skills. The My Small Wonders Curriculum is very hands on and encourages the children to explore, investigate and experiment all while supporting their physical, social, cognitive and emotional development. The possibilities for learning at My Small Wonders are endless with the only limitation being your child's imagination! Through 52 weeks of curriculum featuring an age appropriate theme, color, number, shape and concept we strive to plan activities that initiate learning, promote creativity and nurture a positive self-image in all of the children.

We are blessed to have an incredible team of experienced teachers that are our greatest asset. Our teachers are passionate about providing a nurturing environment that encourages growth, happiness and positive self-esteem. We have numerous master teachers on staff that have degrees in early childhood or a related field. My Small Wonders provides care through workable student to teacher ratios which makes for a more intimate learning experience. With exception of the infant and older toddler room (within which some have two teachers each shift) all of our classrooms have just one morning and one afternoon teacher. The teachers in our classes work together, with equal responsibilities and ownership, to build a strong partnership with parents to ensure the best possible experience for your child. We feel daily communication with families is important to your child's overall success. As such we are proud to offer the Brightwheel Parent Communication system. This virtual 'daily sheet' provides real time communication to parents, which will tell you things about their day such as how much they ate, when they napped, and any supplies that may be needed and more. Our teachers work two shifts: Morning: 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Afternoon: 2:45 p.m. to 6 p.m.

At My Small Wonders the health and safety of your child is our number one priority. Our center is protected

by a state of the art biometric security system that only allows access to the building with a recognized key fob scan. All other visitors must ring the doorbell to gain access into the building. The biometric system is also used for our electronic attendance system. My Small Wonders also employs several other safety tools and procedures including a FEMA certified safe room rated for an F5 tornado on site in the event of severe weather.

My Small Wonders worked closely with a local Nutritionist when planning our menus. We order our food fresh and have it delivered weekly by Ben E. Keith Foods. We post our weekly menus at <http://www.mysmallwonder.com> and in the front vestibule. Nutritious food substitutes may be brought by parents if any foods are unacceptable due to religious and/or medical/allergic reasons. We serve breakfast at 8:00 a.m., lunch at 11 a.m., snack at 2 p.m., and late snack at 5 p.m., which is included in our tuition.

Our management team has worked with local physicians in the development of our illness policy that is strictly enforced and must be agreed to by all parties prior to joining the My Small Wonders family. While it is not possible to avoid all illnesses we can all help keep the spread of illnesses down by teaching our children healthy habits and keeping them home when they are ill. In addition to our staff regularly sanitizing our classrooms and teaching proper hygiene we also employ Jan-Pro Commercial Cleaning Services to thoroughly clean our facility 5 nights a week. Jan-Pro also regularly deep cleans our carpets and resurfaces the floors.

We are proud to be one of the only centers in Oklahoma County to offer WatchMeGrow (see handout). We have secured network cameras in each classroom, in our large indoor playroom and on all 3 playgrounds that feed secure live video footage to WatchMeGrow. Families can then log in at any time during the day to access the live video footage of their child’s classroom. Parents can also choose to add friends/family to access their WMG account. We have actually had grandparents in other countries able to watch their grandchildren while they are here at school! WatchMeGrow offers an app for your smart phone or tablet and can also be accessed from any computer with internet access. There is no additional charge for the WatchMeGrow service; its cost is included in your tuition. Feel free to visit www.watchmegrow.com for more information.
